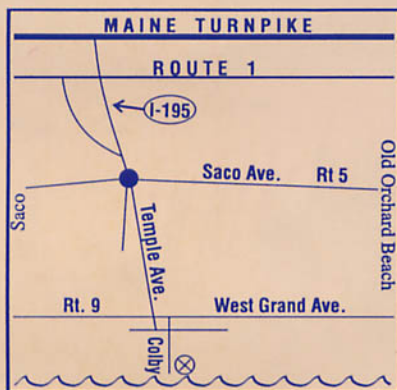




Take Exit 5

The Nautilus is located in Ocean Park, Maine. A quiet, historic community of summer cottages, educational activities and vacation fun. Swimming, surf and sun bathing are a boardwalk away while shuffleboard and tennis are a minute in the other direction.



Facing directly on the ocean, this victorian summer cottage offers large, airy rooms with dramatic views, a screened porch overlooking the sand dunes and beautiful Saco Bay, and a comfortable lounge for TV viewing, reading and relaxing.
